Synod Potluck



The goal of the synod is growing a deeper love for the Eucharist and an active sacramental life, bringing the People of God to the altar. When we gather, we will explore how we can do that as a parish. Uniting all our efforts, we will figure out how we can best accomplish that goal of bringing people to the Eucharist.

We will be having a potluck after mass on **Sunday, March 6th**, and this will take the place of PSR that day. Once we've eaten, we've got two questions to help guide our discussion. Since the end goal is to bring people to the Eucharist, the final thing we will discuss is how to best reach out to those who have stopped attending mass, but also on how to reach out to those who have never experienced our Catholic faith.

This Synod is something we are being asked to do, and we can look on it as a burden imposed by Pope Francis. But the way I am looking at it, is as an opportunity for us to come together as a parish, and have a good discussion on how to Evangelize, make a plan, and start doing it!
