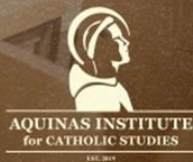

Synod Potluck

The goal of the synod is growing a deeper love for the Eucharist and an active sacramental life, bringing the People of God to the altar. When we gather, we will explore how we can do that as a parish. Uniting all our efforts, we will figure out how we can best accomplish that goal of bringing people to the Eucharist.



We will be having a potluck after mass on **Sunday, March 6th**, and this will take the place of PSR that day. Once we've eaten, we've got two questions to help guide our discussion. Since the end goal is to bring people to the Eucharist, the final thing we will discuss is how to best reach out to those who have stopped attending mass, but also on how to reach out to those who have never experienced our Catholic faith.

This Synod is something we are being asked to do, and we can look on it as a burden imposed by Pope Francis. But the way I am looking at it, is as an opportunity for us to come together as a parish, and have a good discussion on how to Evangelize, make a plan, and start doing it!

10 IDEAS FOR A MORE MEANINGFUL LENTEN SEASON

1. Give up sin Show your love for God by keeping his commandments. Turn away from sins.	2. Fast An empty stomach can lead to more attentive prayer. Give the money you saved on food to others in ams.	3. Pray Be in constant prayer. Pray for your family and friends, for those who suffer, and for the Church and the world.	4. Do good works Help those in need. Pray for them and be ready to serve them in their time of need.
5. Give alms Help the poor and support the good works of the Church. Give cheerfully to God who has given us everything we have.	6. Abstain Give up meat or other desirable foods during Lent, especially on Friday, the day of Christ's saving death on the cross.	7. Do meditative reading Nourish your faith by spending time in quiet reading and reflection. Prayerful reading of God's word each day will open your heart to the Spirit, and let God's thoughts and ways influence yours.	8. Control desire for possessions Build up treasures in heaven rather than on earth. Cut down on material possessions, eliminate frills, lessen wants, share yourself - your time and your talents - with others.
9. Control desire for entertainment Too much entertainment and other distractions can lead to less or no time for the works of the Lord.	10. Carry out duties in life Serve God by living out your vocation in love each day. God is calling each of us to be a living sacrifice. Offer your daily life through Christ!
