

On the first day of the “Holy Week”, we commemorate the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem as reported by all four gospels. The people removed their cloaks, threw leaves of palms and sang hosannas while Jesus, riding on a donkey, passed by. Removing our clothes is a symbolic act of surrender to the Lord. It is a way of becoming open, confessing our sins, and accepting His offer of salvation. No more disguise. No more resistance. On the other hand, the palm has been a traditional symbol of victory and rejoicing (Leviticus 23:40). Thus, by laying palms on the path of Jesus, the people acknowledged that in Jesus, there is victory. The donkey is an animal of peace. Hence, by riding on a donkey, Jesus showed that He is the Prince of Peace.

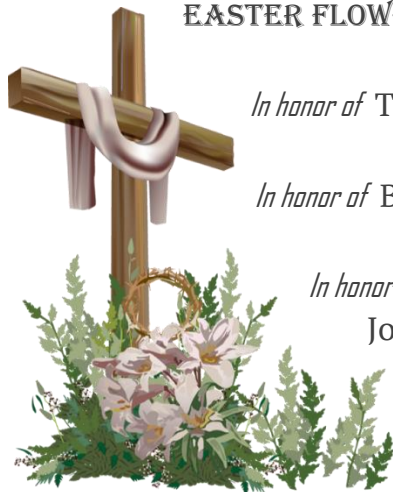
